

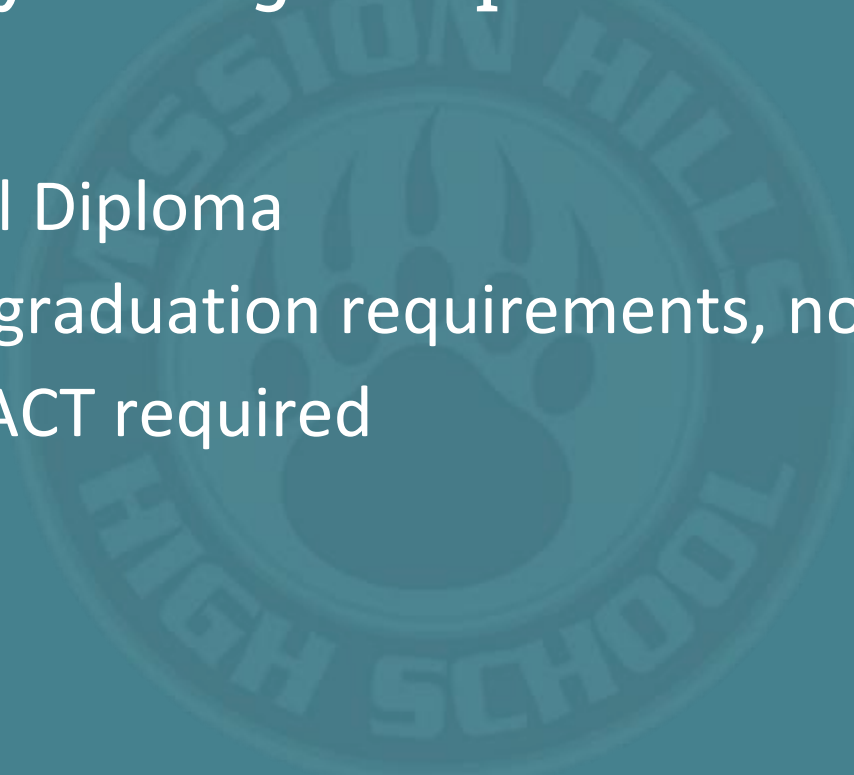

Juniors who do not have at least 155 credits by the end of this semester, June 2019, NOT including summer school, risk not being able to stay at MHHS.

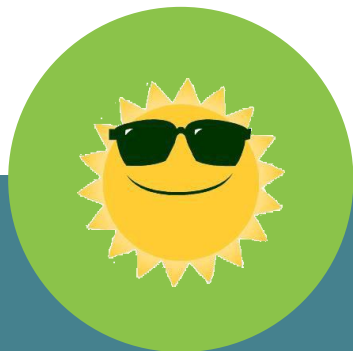
