English	4 years (40 credits)
Math	2 years (20 credits)
Social Studies (History)	3 years (30 credits) 10th grade World History, 11th grade U.S. History, 12th grade Government
Science	2 years (20 credits) Life Science & Physical Science
World Language	2 years (20 credits) Can be satisfied with 1 year of a level 2 course (Successful completion of 10 credits of CTE may count for 1 year of World Language <u>or</u> VAPA)
VAPA	1 year (10 credits) (Successful completion of 10 credits of CTE may count for 1 year of World Language <u>or</u> VAPA)

*Sophomores who do not have **at least 95 credits** by the end of this semester, June, 2019, NOT including summer school, risk not being able to stay at MHHS.*

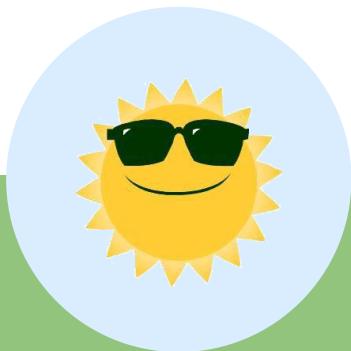
